cultural life and as a model for programs of its kind around the nation. With campuses located at Episcopal High School (Houston) and Austin Middle School (Beaumont), the Conservatory takes place during June July, and enrolls talented fourth

through twelfth grade students from the communities in and around each campus and provides important need-based tuition scholarship support for deserving students.


